General Findings of Fact

The following findings of fact resulted from the review

1. Following the filing of a Due Process Complaint with the Office of the State Superintendent of Education, DCPS entered into a settlement agreement regarding Student [redacted]. This settlement agreement included a change in school placement from [redacted], a nonpublic school.
