

Grievance Issues

We acknowledge that there has been a lapse in time since the filing of this grievance. Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

1. 5-B DCMR 2405.2 (c): Where it is alleged that any student or group of students is being subjected to an arbitrary or unreasonable regulation, procedure, or standard of conduct. You reported that your student, Student [redacted] was arbitrarily placed in a regular English class rather than the Advanced Placement English class at [redacted] for school year [redacted].
