



has completed its review of the above reference. The review identified the following issues under the following provisions of the Code of the District of Columbia:

Grievance Issue

Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the following provisions of the Code of the District of Columbia:

1. 5-BDCMR2405.2(a) Where it is alleged that any student or group of students is being denied access to an adequate educational opportunity. You raise concerns that Student is not able to attend in-person learning more than once per week in order to receive academic support.

Review Procedures

The review included interviews with the following individuals:

- Student's graduation requirements. However, the school offers an additional in-person cohort, the SSC, to provide students social emotional support. According to DCPS Reopen Strong Term Planning, schools may offer this option between one half to four and a half days per week. Student [redacted] has attended in-person learning one day per week in the cohort offering social emotional support for students. This schedule conforms to the DCPS Covid Cohort Guidance. It is not found that Student [redacted] is being denied access to an adequate educational opportunity.

While no violation was found, in order to ensure your concerns are addressed, DCPS has taken the following actions:
