RE Letter of Response for Written Grievance #4160 filed on November 4, 2021

In accordance with Chapter 24 Subtitle 5-B, Section 2405 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DOMR), D.C. Public Schools (DOPS) Comprehensive Alternative Resolution and Equity (CARE) team has completed its review of the above-referenced written grievance.

## **Grievance Issues**

Based on a review of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

 5-B DCMR 2405.2 (e): Where a student is a victim of bullying or harassment, including sexual harassment. It is alleged that Student A at School. These allegations fall under the DC Human Rights Act of 1977



As a result of this review, DOPShas found the following:

DCPS is unable to substantiate 5-B DCMR 2405.2 (e). It is alleged that Student A called Student and during school at School. DCPS CARE did not obtain consent to speak with Student A or Student As a result of the lack of evidence, the CARE Team is unable to substantiate 5-B DCMR 2405.2 (e).

As the complainant, if you are not satisfied with the outcome, you have the right to file an appeal. Appeals must be submitted in writing and received within 10 calendar days of receipt of this notice. Please
