Grievance Issues

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Based on aeview of the information provided, the written grievance raised the following issues under the jurisdiction of this office:

Investigative Procedure

The investigation included interviews with the following individuals:

DCPS CARE unsuccessfully attempted to interview Student B about the allegations raised in this grievance.
