Principal Selection Process - What to Expect?

What qualifications do I need to apply for a principal position with DCPS?

Candidates for principal positions with DCPS have a variety of past professional experiences that have prepared them for the DCPS principal role. To qualify to be a Principal, applicants must have or obtain an <u>Administrative Services Credential (ASC)</u> through the <u>Office of the State Superintendent of Education</u> (OSSE) prior to getting an official offer of employment. In order to be considered for a principal position with DCPS, candidates must meet the qualifications listed below:

- 1. Completed bachelor's degree; and
- 2. Completed master's degree or higher, OR a completed state-approved educator preparation program in school leadership and supervision; and
- 3. At least two years of full-time, instructional leadership experience.

The School Leader Recruitment, Selection and Development Team will review the Instructional Video Activity within 5 business days and candidates will be notified via e-mail of their application status. If a candidate does not receive a status update within 7 business days, please email lead.dc@k12.dc.gov.
